Floor Schedule and Procedure

- **Suspension Bills:** Today, the House will consider several bills on the Suspension calendar. Bills considered on the Suspension calendar are debatable for 40 minutes; may not be amended; and require a two-thirds vote for passage. If a recorded vote is requested, it will be postponed.
 1. **H.R. 189** – To establish the Paterson Great Falls National Park in the State of New Jersey (*Rep. Pascrell – Natural Resources*)
 2. **H.R. 830** - To authorize the exchange of certain lands in Denali National Park in the State of Alaska (*Rep. Young – Natural Resources*)
 3. **H.R. 2197** - To modify the boundary of the Hopewell Culture National Historical Park in the State of Ohio, and for other purposes (*Rep. Space – Natural Resources*)
 4. **H.R. 783** - To modify the boundary of Mesa Verde National Park, and for other purposes (*Rep. Salazar – Natural Resources*)
 5. **H.R. 2094** - To provide for certain administrative and support services for the Dwight D. Eisenhower Memorial Commission, and for other purposes (*Rep. Dennis Moore – Natural Resources*)
 6. **H.R. 523** - To require the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain public land located wholly or partially within the boundaries of the Wells Hydroelectric Project of Public Utility District No. 1 of Douglas County, Washington, to the utility district (*Rep. Hastings (WA) – Natural Resources*)
 7. **H.R. 53** - To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into a long-term lease with the Government of the United States Virgin Islands to

provide land on the island of Saint John, Virgin Islands, for the establishment of a school, and for other purposes (*Rep. Christensen – Natural Resources*)

8. **H.R. 767** - To protect, conserve, and restore native fish, wildlife, and their natural habitats at national wildlife refuges through cooperative, incentive-based grants to control, mitigate, and eradicate harmful nonnative species, and for other purposes (*Rep. Kind – Natural Resources*)
9. **H.R. 1205** - To reauthorize the Coral Reef Conservation Act of 2000, and for other purposes (*Rep. Faleomavaega – Natural Resources*)
10. **H.R. 1462** - To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the implementation of the Platte River Recovery Implementation Program for Endangered Species in the Central and Lower Platte River Basin and to modify the Pathfinder Dam and Reservoir (*Rep. Mark Udall – Natural Resources*)
11. **H.R. 1337** - To provide for a feasibility study of alternatives to augment the water supplies of the Central Oklahoma Master Conservancy District and cities served by the District (*Rep. Cole – Natural Resources*)
12. **H.R. 813** - To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the Prado Basin Natural Treatment System Project, to authorize the Secretary to carry out a program to assist agencies in projects to construct regional brine lines in California, to authorize the Secretary to participate in the Lower Chino Dairy Area desalination demonstration and reclamation project, and for other purposes (*Rep. Gary Miller – Natural Resources*)
13. **H.R. 1803** - To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a feasibility study to design and construct a four reservoir intertie system for the purposes of improving the water storage opportunities, water supply reliability, and water yield of San Vicente, El Capitan, Murray, and Loveland Reservoirs in San Diego County, California in consultation and cooperation with the City of San Diego and the Sweetwater Authority, and for other purposes (*Rep. Hunter – Natural Resources*)
14. **H.R. 1855** - To authorize the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Bureau of Reclamation to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Madera Irrigation District for purposes of supporting the Madera Water Supply Enhancement Project (*Rep. Radanovich – Natural Resources*)
15. **H.Res. ____** - Supporting the goals of National Bullying Prevention Awareness Week (*Rep. McCarthy – Education and Labor*)

16. **H.R. ____** - Third Higher Education Extension Act of 2007 (*Rep. George Miller – Education and Labor*)
17. **H.Res. 472** - Congratulating and commending the Wichita State University women's bowling team for winning the 2007 United States Bowling Congress Intercollegiate Bowling National Championship (*Rep. Tiahrt – Education and Labor*)
