



Dear Representative:

This week the House is expected to take up the conference report on the FY 2008 Labor-Health-Education and Military Construction-VA appropriations bills. The UAW strongly supports this package and urges you to vote for it.

This legislation would provide important increases in funding for education, health care, veterans programs and other vital domestic needs. This would help working families, as well as children, elderly and disabled individuals, and veterans. In particular, this legislation would increase funding for Pell Grants and job training, state unemployment insurance operations, programs to improve access to health care and to protect against a potential influenza pandemic, and efforts to improve workplace health and safety and to address the health care needs of workers who participated in emergency response and recovery at the World Trade Center. It would also provide increased funding for health care for our nation's veterans.

For all of these reasons, the UAW supports the conference report on the FY 2008 Labor-Health-Education and Military Construction-VA appropriations bills. We urge you to vote for this vital legislation.
