

## ***CURE Supports the SAVE Act and Fiscal Responsibility***

Dear Representative:

The Center for Urban Renewal and Education (CURE) strives to fight poverty and restore dignity by supporting faith, freedom and personal responsibility. Protecting the integrity of America's electoral system is critical to ensuring the freedom and dignity of all Americans, including those in our most distressed communities.

We also believe that federal spending must be restrained so that civil society can flourish and support those most in need. **Therefore, we support a continuing resolution that includes the Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) Act and allows the next president and Congress to have a role in the FY 2025 appropriations process.**

At a crucial time in American history, Republicans allied with black Americans to pass the 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Amendments to the Constitution – abolishing slavery, granting citizenship and civil rights to emancipated black Americans, and guaranteeing that the right to vote could not be denied based on “race, color, or previous condition of servitude.”

The SAVE Act protects these important rights by ensuring that black Americans, and all Americans, are not disenfranchised by allowing ineligible people to cancel the impact of their votes. Those who deny that there is a serious risk of this happening are ignoring reality or seeking to gaslight the American people.

The Biden-Harris Administration has released millions of aliens into the United States, and an estimated two million “gotaways” are also known to have entered our country. Non-citizens (including illegal aliens) are eligible for driver's licenses and other benefits, thereby providing opportunities to illegally register to vote. While only U.S. citizens are legally eligible to vote in Federal elections, the National Voter Registration Act undermines this policy because it doesn't allow states to verify citizenship for voting in federal elections.

The SAVE Act takes necessary steps to fix this problem and affirms current law by requiring proof of citizenship to vote in Federal elections. It requires states to establish a program to remove non-citizens from their existing voter rolls and gives them immediate, no-cost access to Federal databases with citizenship information to do so.

**We urge you to protect the integrity of our electoral system and be fiscally responsible by supporting H.R. 9494, Continuing Appropriations and Other Matters Act, 2025.**
