Dear Member of Congress,

This week the US House of Representatives will vote on The Pregnant Students' Rights Act, HR 6359. National Right to Life strongly supports this legislation.

Too often, pregnant and parenting students are unaware of the rights, accommodations, and resources already available to them under federal law. As a result, many students feel pressured to leave school or believe they cannot continue their education while carrying a child to term. The Pregnant Students' Rights Act takes a commonsense step to address this problem by ensuring that institutions of higher education clearly and consistently communicate the resources that are available to their pregnant students.

Importantly, the Pregnant Students' Rights Act does not create new mandates or expand federal authority. Instead, it ensures transparency and awareness of existing rights and protections so that pregnant and parenting students can make informed decisions and continue pursuing their education without discrimination.

By promoting awareness of accommodations and support, this legislation affirms that no student should be forced to choose between their education and carrying a child to term. It encourages a campus environment that respects both academic opportunity and the dignity of motherhood.

For these reasons, **National Right to Life urges you to vote YES on the Pregnant Students' Rights Act. This vote will be considered a key vote for our organization.**
